This cell line needs to be added a Conditioned Medium for culturing.

< A Method of preparing L929 (RCB1451) Conditioned Medium>

- 1. Start cultivating L929 cells at 37 degrees Celsius and cultivate cells for 3 to 5 days after subculturing.
- 2. Collect all cell supernatant when cells reach almost confluence.
- 3. Centrifuge cell supernatant and remove dead cells and cellular debris. (Skip this step if there are few floating debris.)
- 4. Pass cell supernatant through 0.22 μm syringe filter (by using low binding type). If the syringe filter clogs, use 0.45 to 1.0 μm filter prior to 0.22 μm filter.
- 5. Store it at 4 degrees Celsius. For long term storage (more than a month), keep it in -20 degrees Celsius.

NOTE: Culture filtrate (Conditioned Medium) should be stored in small aliquots to avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

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
